



Large tasting of German bio- and eco wines

15 producers from the German wine organization ECOVIN now come to Copenhagen and host a tasting. They bring organic and biodynamic wines from the German vineyards.

The wine production in Germany rapidly is moving towards more sustainable methods in the vineyards. ECOVIN is an organization for German wine producers, all of which emphasize quality and sustainability. Producers are thus all working on organic and biodynamic principles and methods and must meet specific requirements for being admitted to the organization.

Now wine happy Danes have the opportunity to meet 15 members of the organization when they come to Copenhagen. With them they bring some of their best wines which they are ready to pour into the glass and tell how they work in the vineyards. It is the first time ECOVIN hosts a wine tasting in Denmark.

The wine tasting takes place in green surroundings at Restaurant Høst in Copenhagen, Monday November 12th from 5 pm to 7 pm.
